Alton Marketplace Association and the Sierra Club are seeking exhibitors and vendors for the **“Mississippi Earthtones Festival”** at Alton’s Riverfront Park’s Amphitheatre in Downtown Alton on Saturday, September 18, 2010. This is a celebration of Illinois Watersheds through education, recreation and conservation. Our goal is to bring the community down to Riverfront Park’s Amphitheatre from 12pm-9pm where we will have live folk and bluegrass music, hands-on informational booths on river nature, as well as nature arts and crafts, local food, river litter clean-ups, and organized bike rides to the new National Great Rivers Research and Education Center’s (NGRREC) Confluence Field Station. This is the public extension of the elementary school “Dive-In Festival” at LCCC organized by NGRREC. Note: the thrust for environmental education activities is from 12pm-4pm; beer sales will begin at 4:30pm and end at 9pm when the bands stop.

We are looking to showcase any nature or conservation based group that would like to share information about their services with the public and provide activities to youth. We will be advertising and generating coverage through the local media, so we expect over a thousand people to attend the fourth annual **Mississippi Earthtones Festival**.
